Loretta Thurwar & Hamara "Hurricane Staxxx" Stacker are the stars of Chain-Gang All-Stars, the cornerstone of CAPE, or Criminal Action Penal Entertainment, a highly-popular, highlycontroversial, profit-raising program in America's increasingly dominant private prison industry. It's the return of the gladiators & prisoners are competing for the ultimate prize:

their freedom. In CAPE, prisoners travel as Links in Chain-Gangs, competing in death matches for packed arenas with righteous protestors at the gates. Thurwar & Staxxx, both teammates & lovers, are the fan favorites. And if all goes well, Thurwar will be free in just a few matches. As she prepares to leave her fellow Links, she considers how she might help preserve their humanity, in defiance of these so-called games. However, CAPE's corporate owners will stop at nothing to protect their status quo, & the obstacles they lay in Thurwar's path have devastating consequences. Chain-Gang All-Stars is a kaleidoscopic, excoriating look at the American prison system's unholy alliance of systemic racism, unchecked capitalism, & mass incarceration, & a clear-eyed reckoning with what freedom in this country means.

It's the opening night of The Manor, & no expense, small or large, has been spared. The infinity pool sparkles; crystal pouches for guests' healing have been placed in the Seaside Cottages & Woodland Hutches; the "Manor Mule" cocktail (grapefruit, ginger, vodka, & a dash of CBD oil) is being poured with a heavy hand. Everyone is wearing linen. And yet, outside The Manor's immaculately kept grounds, an ancient forest bristles with secrets. The local community resents what they see as The Manor's intrusion into the local woods & attempts to privatize the beach, & small skirmishes have erupted on the edges of the property between locals & the staff. And the whispers keep coming, about an old piece of pagan folklore - the Night Birds, an avenging force that can be called upon to make right wrongs that elude the law. On



the Sunday morning of opening weekend, the local police are called. There's been a fire. A body's been discovered. Something's not right with the guests. What happened on the grounds of The Manor over the past 36 hours? And who--or what--is the cause?

The only place small-town outcast Alex Lawson fits in is the online fan forum she built for The Arcane Files, a longrunning werewolf detective show. Her dedication to archiving fictional supernatural lore made her Internet-famous, even if she harbors a secret disdain for the show's star, Devin Ashwood. (Never meet your heroes-sometimes they turn out to be The Worst.) Ever since his show went off the air, Devin and his career have spiraled, but waking up naked in the woods outside his LA home with no memory of the night before is a new low. It must have been a coincidence that the once-in-a-century Wolf Blood Moon crested last night. The claws, fangs, and howling are a little more difficult to explain away. Desperate for answers, Devin finds Alex—the closest thing to an expert that exists. If

only he could convince her to stop hating his guts long enough to help.... Once he makes her an offer she can't refuse, these reluctant allies lower their guards trying to wrangle his inner beast. Unfortunately, getting up close and personal quickly comes back to bite them.






#### **Using Deep Search**

When you search for a book title or author, the immediate results will be the options your library has available at that time. However, there's always a chance the library could add more titles at a later date. Or, if you're searching for a book that isn't published yet, it may not be a part of the database quite yet. Enter **Deep Search!** 

When you search, scroll down to the end of the results, and you'll see a button called **Deep Search**. After you click on it, you may see your book pop up and a **Notify Me** button appear. You can click **Notify Me** so you'll get a notification if/when the library acquires any copies of the book.

This is a great way to stay on top of new book releases, so you can put an upcoming book on hold as soon as it's available on Libby!


#### Franklin Welcomes New Library Assistant

Join us inside the library at 12:00 PM to hear the discussion & get all your questions answered from this year's panelists!












#### **VERITY**
